

To prove their case the wolves (pink rectangles) were taken in GMU 19C, district attorney Scot Leaders and Trooper Brett Gibbens gave the orange GMU 19C boundary line map to the jury. In truth, the lower left orange boundary should have crossed where the green line is – meaning the wolves were actually taken in GMU 19D.
